



STATE TEAM POSITION DESCRIPTION

POSITION TITLE: Team Judge

REPORTS TO: Team Manager

LOCATION: Varied

Gymnastics QLD is the peak body responsible for the management, coordination, development and promotion of gymnastics in Queensland. Gymnastics QLD is an affiliate member of the Australian Gymnastics Federation.

Objectives:

The stated objectives of Gymnastics Queensland are to:

- Encourage, develop, promote and control Gymsports throughout the State of Queensland
- Establish and maintain, throughout Queensland, a uniform code of rules and regulations to govern Gymsports under its jurisdiction
- Develop a network of successful member clubs across Queensland to deliver quality Gymsports programs
- Provide services and support, to member clubs, coaches, judges and administrators, which is second to none.
- Encourage community health, welfare, physical education and research through gymnastics
- Regulate, supervise, coordinate and promote Gymsports activities, programs, competitions and events
- Facilitate cooperation between members of the Association and external organisations, bodies and individuals
- Promote membership of the Association and foster the interests of its members
- Affiliate with organisations and any other bodies to further the purposes of the Association
- Provide a means by which Clubs in Queensland can become affiliated to further these purposes.

Position Objective:

The Team Judge is required to:

- Provide technical assistance to ensure the state team competes at their highest level.

Specific Duties:

The Team Judge will perform the following duties:

- a) Represent their State by impartial judging at all times.
- b) Assist the Team Manager and the team wherever possible and when requested.
- c) Be expert and appropriately qualified in judging and assist the Coach on request by being present at training sessions to mark and evaluate exercises.
- d) Attend and report on Judging conferences, meetings etc. and keep the Manager, Coach and Team informed, particularly on any factors that could improve or affect their performance.
- e) Consult with the Team Manager on all matters and specifically if there are any problems perceived or otherwise with other team members.
- f) Submit in writing to the State Judging Coordinator (SJC), any relevant issues or concerns specifically related to assist judging development in the State as well as improve Team performance.
- g) Liaise with the SJC any specific details regarding Chaperone duties and transportation required. The SJC will discuss the needs with the Team Manager and advise of the outcome.
- h) Read, understand and comply with all relevant Gymnastics QLD policy and procedure with particular emphasis upon the Gymnastics QLD Member Protection & Child Protection Policies, including the Role Specific Codes of Conduct.

Essential Attributes:

To be considered for this role you will be an experienced judge with the required level of judging accreditation. You will be a team player with a willingness to assist coaches on technical matters during team training. You will be responsible, and you will have the desire to represent QLD to the highest standard.

Reviews:

Collectively, under the co-ordination of the SJC, contribute to a written team report submitted no later than two weeks following the completion of the event to the GQ CEO. The report should contain feedback on areas that worked well, areas that need attention and recommendations for future teams.
